



Creating a plan for the future can be overwhelming. Take the guesswork out and join LOV Inc.'s Fearless Future workshop. Under the expert guidance of our facilitators, our supportive workshop series empowers families and individuals with disabilities to develop a concrete plan, get questions answered, and learn from experts. Optionally, participants may elect to attend an additional session, only for individuals with disabilities. In this additional session, individuals with disabilities will learn about making a Fearless Future plan, practice self-determination skills, and become better self-advocates for their current and future support needs.

Outcomes include:

- Participants will learn about making a Fearless Future plan and practice self-determination skills to become better advocates for their current and future support needs.
- Participants and families will record a social, emotional, medical, and financial history of their loved one, and create opportunities for involving natural and paid supporters in the plan of support.
- Participants will have support to start or strengthen a Circle of Support.
- Optional only session to explore their current and future support needs.

What:

Five workshops where participants and families create an Individualized Fearless Future Plan. There is an opportunity for the participant to participate in an additional meeting, facilitated by LOV Inc. staff. Individual support is available before, during and after the workshop series.

When:

Wednesday evenings, 6-8:30 p.m., over a 2-3 month time frame

Cost:

The Fearless Future Workshop can be paid for with waiver funds (IRIS, Family Care, CLTS) or private funds. The workshops cost \$115 per session for a total cost of \$575. To participate in an additional participant-only session, there will be an additional one-time \$115 fee, bringing the total cost to \$690. The workshop cost includes the materials, facilitator's time for five workshops, customized support, and individualized guidance to start a Circle of Support.
